

# Minnesota Health Information Exchange (MN HIE)

## What is MN HIE?

MN HIE is the state-wide secure electronic network designed to share clinical and administrative data among providers in Minnesota and bordering states.

Our purpose is to improve the health of all Minnesotans through more informed decision-making by the provider and patient at the point of care.

- Over 4 million Minnesota residents are included in MN HIE's Secure Patient Directory (SPD).
- Patients provide consent at each visit and can opt-out of sharing any clinical information.

## MN HIE Benefits

### Improves clinical and administrative efficiency

MN HIE exchanges important clinical information not previously or readily available to providers. MN HIE services can be embedded into an existing EMR, secure Web application or via interoperable transaction. We also offer administrative staff quick access to eligibility checking for efficient patient management.

### Better coordination of care

Providers now have quicker access to a broad set of patient clinical information from multiple data sources. This clinical information includes: lab history, immunization history and submission, medication history, ePrescribing and exchange of medical record information.

### Strengthen current & future HIT investments

MN HIE interfaces with your existing technology and will be able to adapt to future, expanded technology. MN HIE can also help maximize your access to Federal stimulus funds and other incentives for adoption of health information technology and demonstration of meaningful use.

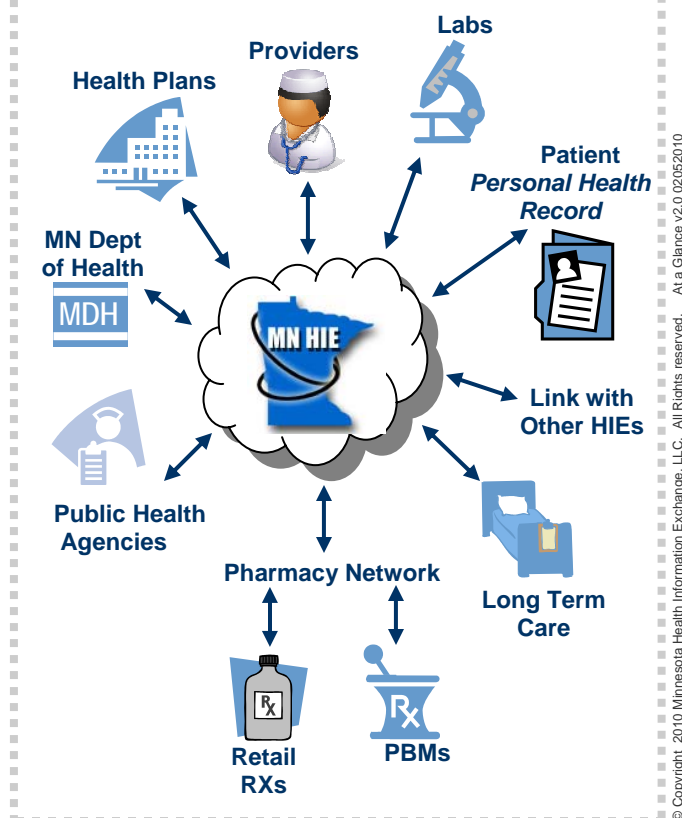
If your organization is currently participating in a local exchange initiative, MN HIE can help you link with other providers.
